HOW YOU'LL BE NOTIFIED

CCVI is committed to the safety of our students, staff, and families. When inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances affect transportation or operations, we will make adjustments to the school day.

It's important that you are aware of the different policies we have in place to ensure that you receive all communications in a timely manner.

All communications regarding a school cancellation or schedule adjustment will be sent prior to 5 a.m., and if no communication is sent prior to that time, CCVI will operate as normal.

TERMS TO KNOW

- Cancellation** The decision to close school for the full day is made the morning or evening before school. The first 3 missed days due to cancellations will be made up at the end of the school year. On the 4th cancellation, we will transition to virtual instruction which will be continued for the remainder of the days missed.
- Late Start** A late start will cancel all classes for students who participate in half days during the morning at CCVI. All full day students will begin classes at 10 a.m. Students receiving half day services with an afternoon time slot will begin as normal at noon.
- Early Release** While there is no set dismissal time for an early release, CCVI will be in constant communication with parents if potential conditions appear to cause concern for a full day of services.
